

2021 ACTIVE KIDS GRANT GUIDELINES

YOUR COMPLETE GUIDE TO APPLYING FOR AN ACTIVE KIDS GRANT WITH THE AUSTRALIAN SPORTS FOUNDATION





GRANT GUIDELINES

The Active Kids grant program has been established by the Australian Sports Foundation (ASF) with the aim of providing every child with the active childhood they deserve by supplying them with the equipment and uniform they need to participate in sporting activities.



The grant will be focusing on volunteer-run grassroots and community clubs and organisations with young members aged 20 or younger, with priority given to those that have been most disadvantaged financially by the impact of Covid-19.

Grants will be awarded in the form of equipment supplied by HART Sport and onfield uniform supplied by ISC. There are no cash grants available in the 2021 Active Kids grant round.

Applications will be accepted from 9am (AEDT) Monday 13 December 2021 to 5pm (AEDT) Monday 24 January 2022.

OBJECTIVES AND ELIGIBILITY

Active Kids grants are intended to assist clubs and organisations to support and encourage young Australians, aged 20 or under, to participate in sport.

Grants are for the provision of sports equipment and on-field uniform supplied by the ASF's partners. No cash grants are available in the 2021 Active Kids grant round.

Up to \$2,500	GST inclusive (equipment only)
Up to \$5,000	GST inclusive (equipment only)
\$5,000-\$10,000	GST inclusive (uniform only*)
Up to \$10,000	GST inclusive (can be equipment and/or uniform*)

^{*} Uniform orders must be for a minimum value of \$5,000 GST inclusive. Clubs that are restricted to using specific apparel providers should check with their governing body, League or Association before applying for a uniform grant.

The Active Kids grant can be used to encourage youth participation in the following ways:

- Engagement of new participants, and/or
- Retention of existing participants







WHAT GRANT REQUESTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED

The following do not fit the criteria for this grant program.

- Sports equipment or uniforms intended for use by participants aged over 20.
- Sports equipment or uniforms that will not be used to encourage and support sport participation by children and young Australians.

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

Organisations and clubs can only submit one application per ground round, and must be:

- volunteer-run and not affiliated with a professional club,
- non-profit with an Australian Business Number (ABN),
- signed up with the Australian Sports Foundation. To register for free please <u>click here</u>,
- able to complete an equipment and/or uniform order by COB Friday 28
 February 2022, and
- willing to provide an impact report and/or host visitors, as requested.

INELIGIBLE APPLICANTS

- Professional organisations and clubs
- Clubs and organisations that have paid administration staff
- Applicants that do not meet the Eligibility Criteria (see above)





PROCESS FOR APPLICANTS

The following information will guide you through the application process.

It's a good idea to make sure you have everything you need so you're prepared and ready to go.





1: CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY

Ensure that your club/organisation and its grant request meet the eligibility criteria.

The eligibility criteria is available on page 3 in this document.



2: REGISTER YOUR CLUB/ ORGANISATION

If you're not already signed up with the ASF, that's your next step.

Signing up is free and only takes 5 minutes online here.



3: OBTAIN YOUR HART SPORT AND/OR ISC OUOTE

Get your HART Sport equipment quote here.

Get your ISC uniform Quote <u>here</u>.



4: COMPLETE GRANT APPLICATION

To apply online for a 2021 Active Kids grant via SurveyMonkey Apply, please click here and use your ASF portal username and password to login.

Remember, you will need:

- your ASF member number, which can be located in the Account section of your ASF portal (top right), and
- your equipment and/or uniform quote.



5: ATTACH HART SPORT AND/OR ISC QUOTE

All applicants will be required to attach at least one quote equal to the value of the grant being requested.

The process to attach documents is simple, however the applicant should ensure they have the relevant document/s saved on the computer they're using to submit the application.







ASSESSMENT PROCESS

The intended outcome of the Active Kids grant program is to support and encourage young Australians to participate in sport. Eligible applications are assessed according to how well their grant request aligns with this intended outcome and the number of successful applicants will depend on the funds available.



ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

The assessment criteria for the 2021 Active Kids grant round is as follows:


- The legitimacy of the application and its alignment to our intended outcomes,
- How well the grant request provides opportunities for Australian children aged 20 or younger to participate in sport, and
- The quality of the Case for Support provided in the application.

NOTIFICATION OF OUTCOME


All applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application Monday 7 February 2022.

Successful applicants will receive confirmation of the value of their awarded grant, and guidance about how their order can finalised with HART Sport and/or ISC.*

*The lead time for the delivery of ISC uniform orders can be up to 6-8 weeks, so grant recipients should place their order as soon as possible after notification and ideally before Tuesday 15 February 2022.
